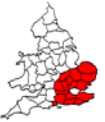
## The Development Control Training Course

### The Training Programme

TMS Consultancy has been commissioned by the Southern and Eastern Development Control Forum and IHIE to deliver a six day residential course. There are two sessions, two months apart, each three days long with associated assignments to be completed at work in your own time.

The course is for development control staff with only a few years' experience. It is at technician level, level 3 in the national qualifications framework.

### Assessment of Assignments

Successful completion of four marked assignments leads to the award of the **Development Control Course Certificate** endorsed by IHIE, TMS and SEDCF in

**Appeal statements**

**Road safety audits**

**Transport Assessments.**

You have 2 to 3 months in which to complete the assignments, each of which demands around three days' preparation. This may be at work or in your own time. You are looking to produce a report of typically 4 to 6 pages long with supporting documents for each one.

Each assignment is marked for Technical and Policy Understanding (15) and Presentation (5). Exceptional performance (17/20) is recognised by a Merit pass and an overall Distinction (68/80 marks) may be awarded.
